Our topic this half term is 'Anglo Saxons'.

Big and strong, powerful and brave, the Saxons will guide us through what Britain was like after the Roman withdrawal. We will sail back in time to where battles were rife and fear reigned as the Anglo Saxons invaded Britain's shores. We will find out about the lives of the Saxons, including how they lived and where they came from.
