Our topic this half term is 'Land Ahoy!'

Ahoy There! It's time to set sail with Captain Blade and join his pirate crew. Do you have what it takes to become one of his shipmates? Join shipmate Sam Silver to travel back in time to explore what life as a pirate on the open sea was really like and discover more about these famous pirates and their Caribbean home. We might even discover some pirate treasure along the way!

As writers, we will be trying to persuade Captain Blade to allow us to join his crew before hopefully getting to write our own pirate adventure tale.

As readers, we will continue Phase 6 phonics and aim to improve our fluency and reading stamina in order to help us answer questions in more detail.

In Maths, we will deepen our knowledge of 2D and 3D shape before moving onto numbers within 1000 to help us with measuring capacity and weight.

In Science, we will continue our learning on living things and their habitats – exploring microhabitats in greater detail.

In Computing, we will learn why emails are used and how to read and respond to an email from a fictional character. This learning will be supported by online safety discussions about online relationships.

In Design and Technology, we will learn about different types of mechanisms: levers and sliders, to make a moving picture for our pirate adventure tale.

In Music, we will identify what rhythm is being clapped to help us begin to use stick notation (crochet and quavers).

In PSHE, our focus is on dreams, aspirations and skills.

In PE, we will take part in team games and develop our dance skills.

In RE, we will learn what festivals Ramadan and Eid al-Fitr are and recognise the commitments made by Muslims.
