WB: 28.04.2025	ge <i>After all other sounds, whether consonants or vowels, the 'j' sound is spelt as -ge at the end of a word</i>	age, huge, change, charge, cage, stage, wage, page, large, lodge
WB: 05.05.2025	-ly endings <i>Where the root word does not change</i>	badly, nearly, playfully, carefully, sadly, usually, firstly, lastly, finally, shyly
WB: 12.05.2025	s making the 'z' sound	television, treasure, vision, usual, unusual, Asia, casual, measure, pleasure, decision
WB: 17.03.2025	Changing the y to an i when adding ed	spied, cried, tried, worried, copied, married, carried, replied, fried, hurried
