WB: 06.01.2025	Words ending in -ssion and -sion	expression, discussion, confession, permission, possession, occasion, explosion, corrosion
WB: 13.01.2025	Mixed word endings	believably, considerably, hospitality, valuably, adorably, possibility, collectability, availability, inevitably, tolerable
WB: 20.01.2025	-ible	inedible, illegible, incomplete, incomprehensible, unconvertible, unfeasible, implausible, irreversible, indigestible, intangible
WB: 27.01.2025	Words including 'fer' (the f is doubled when 'fer' is stressed)	differing, difference, suffering, sufferance, inference, inferable, preference, reference, transference, conference
WB: 03.02.2025	-ance	ignorance, tolerance, radiance, abundance, allowance, assistance, defiance, dominance, reluctance, significance
WB: 10.02.2025	-ence	magnificence, independence, obedience, affluence, consequence, preference, influence, presence, recurrence, audience
