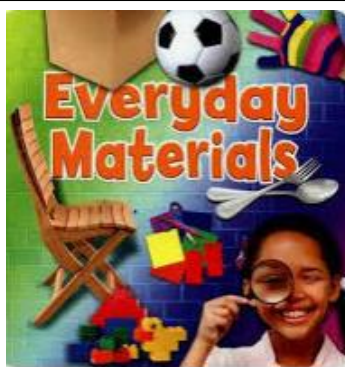




## Curriculum Information



### Autumn 1 Year 1



**Our topic this half term is 'Everyday Materials'.** Our journey starts when we meet three little pigs who set off to build themselves new homes but someone big and bad soon comes looking for a tasty snack. The pigs manage to outwit the wolf and he disappears. How will they find him and will they ever become friends?

**As writers,** we will be exploring adjectives that can be used to create a wanted poster, retelling a story and writing non-fiction texts.

**As readers,** we will share a number of books –The Three Little Pigs and Everyday Materials. We will also be exposed to a range of books during our guided reading sessions.

**In Maths,** we will explore numbers within 10. This will include representing numbers, finding 1 more and 1 less, doubling and halving and exploring addition and subtraction. We will also be identifying and classifying 2D and 3D shapes, investigating repeated patterns and using and following instructional and positional language.

**In Science,** we will find out about materials and their properties.

**In Art,** we will be looking at some of the work created by Van Gogh and be creating our own 'Starry Night' masterpieces using some of the techniques taught.

**In Design and Technology,** we will be finding out where flour comes from before making pitta bread pockets.

**In Computing,** we will be exploring Purple Mash to find resources and adding pictures and text to a document.

**In Geography,** we will be exploring the location of the equator and the North and South Poles and investigating the temperature of countries located near to the equator.

**In Music,** we learn a song about menus, play classroom instruments and begin to compose.

**In PSHE,** we will learn about protective behaviours and introducing My Happy Mind.

**In PE,** we will take part in dance and team games.

**In RE,** we will learn about Christianity and the creation story.
