Week 1	Words that have 'kn' and 'gn' for /n/, and 'wr' for /r/	knock, knit, knee, knife, knight, know gnash, gnaw, gnome, sign, design
Week 2		wrap, wrong, write, wrong, wrote, wriggle Prickly spellings: once, two Homophone: knight/night
Week 3	Dropping the 'e' when adding the suffixes -ed, -ing, -er, - est and -y	like (liked, liking) scare (scared, scaring) dance (danced, dancing) hope (hoped, hoping)
Week 4		late (later, latest) nice (nicer, nicest) safe (safer, safest) brave (braver, bravest) scare - scary, shine - shiny, noise - noisy, ice - icy Prickly spellings: any, many Homophone: one/won
Week 5	Words ending in 'ge' or 'dge' The /j/ sound spelled 'j' or 'g'	fudge, fridge, dodge, badge Homophone: where/wear
