

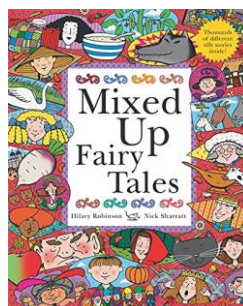


Curriculum Information

Our topic this half term is 'Muck, Mess and Mixtures'

It's time to get creative! Let's join Roald Dahl's George by mixing our own marvellous creations. By mixing colours and applying materials we will create our own unique masterpieces and have some fun getting messy in the process. Thinking about mess, we have lots of scientific investigations to perform and we will create our own healthy recipes to form part of a balanced diet.

As writers, we will be improving our descriptive writing and storytelling by using a variety of traditional tales.

As readers, we will continue with our phonics and guided reading sessions using Little Wandle, Letters and Sounds Revised.

In Maths, we will continue with measures: time and money, and build upon our Year 1 fractions and shape work.

In Science, we will learn about animals and humans. This includes learning about lifecycles and the basic needs of animals and humans.

In Art, we will be exploring the use of colour in abstract art, learning to mix tones and shades as well as exploring the works of Mondrian and Rothko.

In Computing, we will be creating simple algorithms and animations. We will also be continuing online safety learning and celebrating Safer Internet Day.

In Design and Technology, we will understand how a balanced diet contributes to a healthy lifestyle and make our own couscous salad using taught cutting techniques.

In Music, we will be playing and composing pieces on tuned percussion instruments.

In PSHE, our focus is on health and wellbeing including dental and personal hygiene. We will welcome Warwickshire Road Safety team members to learn about scooter safety.

In PE, we will take part in dance for different moods and Team Games.
